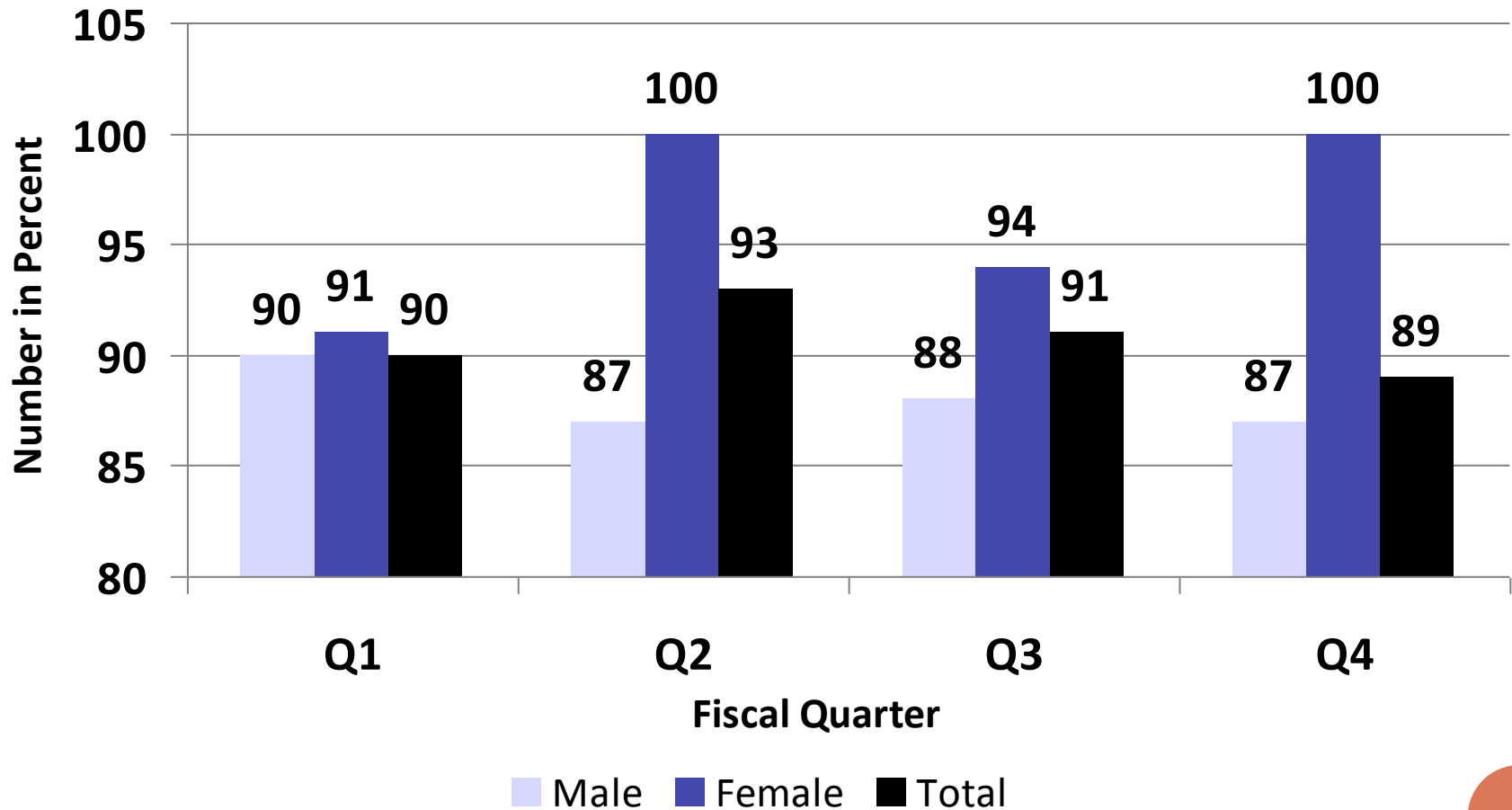
Why ATD?

- **Cost Effective**

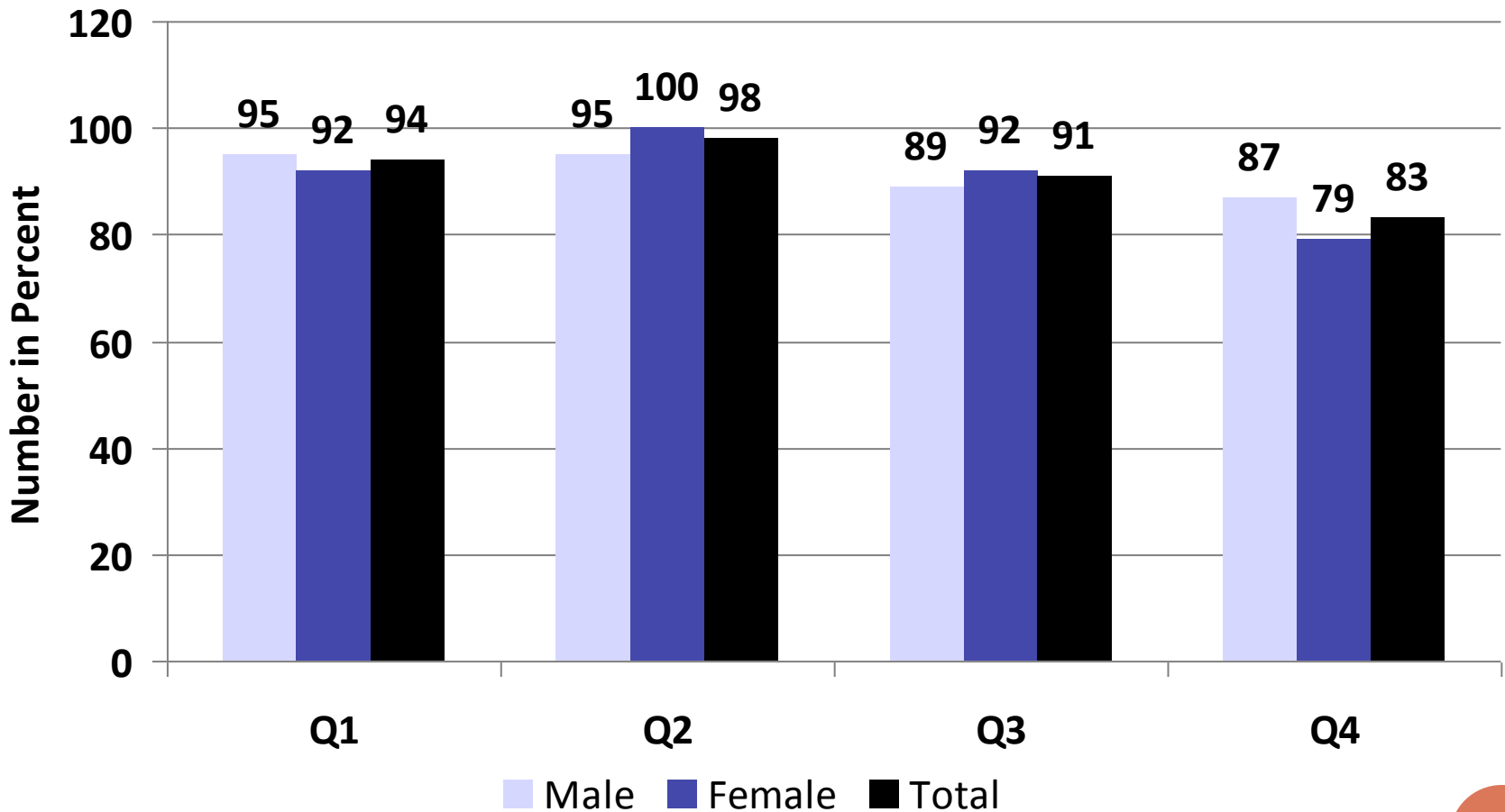

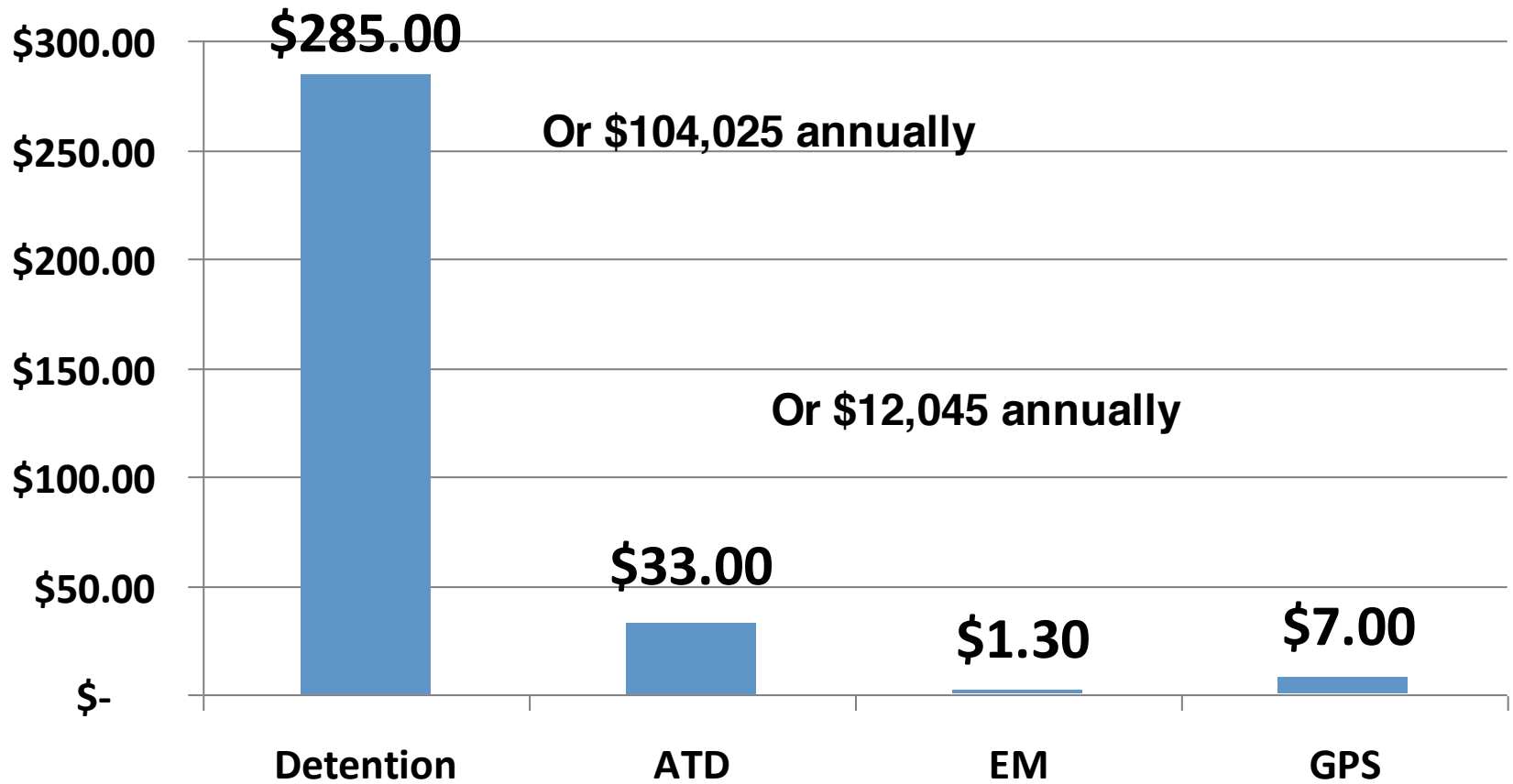

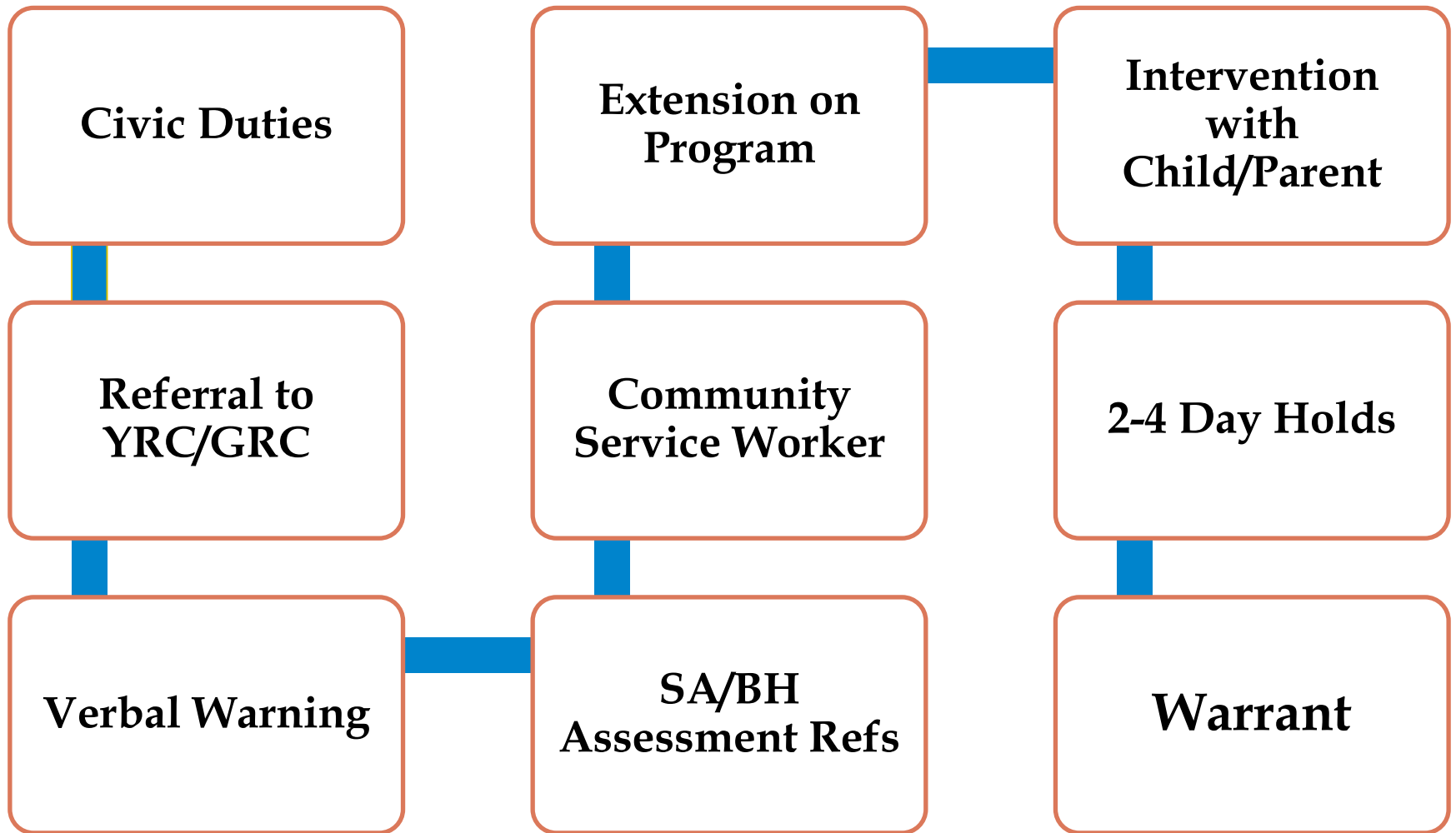

INTERVENTIONS AND SANCTIONS



TRAINING

- **Initially we didn't provide specialized JDAI training to the ATD Staff**
- **Currently, training is part of the new employee training**
- **Managers model the JDAI Philosophy**
- **Provided training to JDAI stakeholders on the JDAI Philosophy**
 - **CCA, PD, JPO's , Courts**

OBSTACLES

- **Lack of initial employee screening**
- **Lack of training and oversight**
- **Change of philosophy from custodial supervision to community supervision**
- **Stakeholder**
 - Selected Children's Court Attorney's have not fully bought into the JDAI philosophy
 - Territorial concerns voiced by individual Juvenile Probation Officers
